HOW TO RECOGNIZE CYBER BULLYING

Cyberbullying is when someone intentionally spreads false, embarrassing, or harmful content about people on or via digital or electronic devices, apps, platforms, and websites.

Some examples of cyberbullying include when someone



Sends mean or threatening messages to them via email, phone text, or instant messaging apps



Posts hurtful things about them online, maybe even on a dedicated blog



Forwards their emails or text messages to other people without permission



Steals their passwords and sends messages or posts pretending to be them



Takes pictures of them without permission—sometimes an altered photo—and posts them online
